Building skills in a specific area

More people are seeking to boost their knowledge in areas specific to their career, and some employers will pay tuition for students seeking training in an area related to their job.

Whether you're interested in taking just a class or two to increase specific skills, or you're seeking a new career option through a certificate, associate degree or program for transfer to a four-year institution, MCC has a variety of options that are aligned with high demand, high-wage careers.

Reverse transfer program

Some academic credits for coursework completed at another community college or university may transfer back to MCC to satisfy associate degree requirements.

If you have completed 15 or more credits at MCC, you need only to arrange for transcripts from universities and colleges that you transferred to after leaving MCC. If classes that transfer back meet the requirements of an MCC degree, you could earn another degree for free.

Research shows that earning an associate degree or certificate provides an additional credential that makes you more competitive when applying for jobs and scholarships.

Online learning

Online courses offer the flexibility to work on the skills you choose in your own environment. During the 2017 academic year, 40 percent of MCC's students were enrolled in at least one online or hybrid course. A hybrid course is delivered partially online and partially face-to-face.
